

BLACKOUT LINING

There are numerous benefits to selecting a blackout lining for your next project. Whether your reason is a darkened room for better rest, movie night with the family, saving money on your energy expenses or to protect furniture and flooring from excessive sunlight and UV rays we want to make sure you are aware of the cons as well.

When using blackout lining in conjunction with a light-colored face fabric, the pigment may show through as seen in the image below (1).

Blackout linings are manufactured by coating a fabric with layers of acrylic foam to increase its light-blocking properties. Pinholes, which are needle size spots where light can be seen through, are inherent to coated fabrics and are difficult to avoid as seen in image (2) below.
