STAGE ONE: HOW TO USE THE C.C. STYLE GUIDE

Step 1) Determine the corresponding numeric fabric price code from the RM COCO fabric retail price list or at RMCOCO.com.

If you are using your own material, refer to the C.O.M. charts in this book for your fabric price code.

Step 2) Select your product code from this workroom book. The product code will be listed on the product style page.

Step 3) Open your Custom Creations Retail Price List and turn to the corresponding price code.

Step 4) Simply locate the desired size of your treatment under the appropriate product codes and you'll find the retail price of your design.

Stage Two: Place a Quote or Order

Custom Creations offers online quoting and ordering of Panel Program Draperies and Custom Pleated Draperies. Select from the vast RM COCO fabric inventory or use your own material by selecting C.O.M. Quoting on all products is available through our Custom Creations Customer Service Department.

Step 1) Fill out the appropriate workroom order form for the treatment you have chosen in Stage One.

Step 3) When your order is received, it will be reviewed, processed and added to our production schedule. It at this time, Custom Creations has any questions or problems with your order, you will be contacted to clarify and finalize your order.

Ship dates will be assigned when all questions have been answered and the fabric is available to begin production. You will be emailed an order acknowledgement with and

<u>ESTIMATED</u> ship date. Please take the time to review and verify that all information is correct on the acknowledgement as this will stand as the <u>final workorder</u>. **Note: Multiple item orders can only be shipped complete upon request.

Step 4) Your order is in production and will ship when completed.

STAGE THREE: RECEIVING YOUR ORDER

Step 1) Remove your custom made treatments from their shipping boxes as soon as they are received. Items left in boxes will wrinkle.

Step 2) Check the order to make sure that you have received all items ordered and that there has been no damage during shipping. If damages have occurred, please let a Custom Creations Representative know as soon as possible.

Step 3) Enjoy your new custom made designs by Custom Creations.

Polices & Procedures

Cancellations/Order Changes

Cancellations after labor has begun will result in a partial labor charge, and if necessary, a restocking fee and/or fabric cost if fabric has already been cut from inventory.

Rework/Return Policy

Custom ordered products may not be returned except for defective workmanship and the return request must be made within 30 days from the date of invoice.

We reserve the right to rework any custom products.

We will not reimburse for labor not performed by our company and we will not rework after our product has been altered by another workroom. Under no circumstances shall our liability extend to interest, shipping, insurance, re-installation, trip charges or to any consequential damages of any nature.

For purposes of Custom Creation's guarantees, the following conditions <u>will not</u> be considered defective:

- 1. Flaws visible only when fabric is held against light.
- 2. Fading due to atmospheric conditions or undue exposure to the sun.
- Ordered filled with more than one piece, unless special instructions have been received in writing at the time of order placement.
- 4. Variation in dye lot, unless a cutting was requested and approved by the buyer prior to placement of the order.
- 5. Patterns or repeats that do not match due to repeat variations.
- Natural characteristics as described in the Fabric Characteristics & Care Guide.
- 7. Wear.
- 8. Handwoven/Silk fabrics.
- 9. Wrinkles during shipping.

FABRIC CHARACTERISTICS & CARE

These characteristics are not considered defects and therefore, not reasons for returning fabric.

Bow, Bias and Seam Matching

The industry standards are 1-1/2" to 2" for bow and bias. Some print and solid patterns may have difficulty with seams matching.

Dyelot Match

If an exact dyelot match is required, please send swatch of material for match. Otherwise, we will ship the dyelot as close to the sample as our stock permits. We cannot accept the return of cut yardage material for full credit because the dyelot is off in cases where a swatch was not sent with the order for match.

Finishes

Applied finishes may help fabrics resist soil and stains, but does not eliminate the necessity of properly caring for fabrics.

Flaring

Flaring custom drapery returns is a natural characteristic of many fabrics, especially those woven from synthetic fibers. If flaring is a problem with your client, we recommend memory stitching when fabricating custom draperies. Some casements and polyesters have a tendency to flare. Flaring is not a reason for return.

Casement, Hand Woven, and Silk Fabrics

Many fabrics are created by home hand weavers thus creating unique qualities. Dyelot variations, inconsistent weaving, heavy threads, wrinkling, flaws, colored yarns, holes, pattern repeats that vary within the same yardage, loose threads, missing yarns and threads, missing beads, pearls, incomplete appliques, puckering around embroidered silks and inconsistent embroidery are natural characteristics. Protect all silks from direct and indirect sun as fading and disintegration are common. Bow and bias may be in excess of industry standards. These fabrics may also have a tendency to stretch in length. These characteristics are not considered defects and therefore, not reasons for returning fabric. Backing is recommended for upholstery use.

Heat Sensitive Fabrics

Many fibers used in drapery fabric construction are sensitive to heat and can cause puckering and hiked hems. Polyester and linen are the most sensitive to heat and must be fabricated with a cool iron only. Acrylic and modacrylic fibers are also sensitive to heat. When measuring a drapery prior to fabrication, check to make sure that the drapery will not hang over a hot air duct or a baseboard heater as it will often affect the drapery once it is hung. Heat sensitive fabrics that are steamed or ironed often shrink or pucker.

Pattern Repeat

Pattern repeat, as listed in this catalog and on samples, is approximate only and can vary slightly from one printing to the next. We cannot guarantee repeat matching.

Puckering

It is natural for some fabrics (i.e. hammered satins, satin stripes) to have a puckered or slightly wrinkled appearance. This is a characteristic of today's more relaxed, casual fabric constructions.

Sheers

Sheers will <u>intensify</u> in color when made into a drapery. Fold a sheer sample three times for a true color reading. Darker sheers have more of a tendency to fade or disintegrate than lighter sheers.

Shrinking and Length Fluctuations

Be tolerant of normal fluctuations in lengths of draperies. Few fabrics are completely stable. Fabrics breathe and absorb moisture, resulting in stretching or shrinking. Fabrics placed over or near heating and cooling vents may react to a much greater degree. We will not be responsible should this situation occur. A 2% to 3% change is reasonable. Allow sufficient fabric in the hems for later adjustments, should it be necessary. Fabrics that are steamed or ironed often shrink or pucker.

Sun Protection

Fabrics should be protected from the sun. We do not guarantee against fading or color fastness. Draperies should be lined. Shades should be drawn during the day and glass protection should be used whenever possible. Window glass magnifies the destructive elements in the rays of the sun. The winter sun and reflection from the snow are even more harmful than the summer sun and may cause disintegration. Colors can fade by oxidation, "gas fading", if fabrics are kept in storage for too long a period without airing. Some colors are more sensitive than others. Impurities in the air may cause as much fading as direct rays of the sun.

Synthetic Fibers

Despite the impressive strides in the advancement of the technology of weaving synthetic fibers, performance will vary with the construction of the fabric and its application. Whole or partial synthetic constructions may have a tendency to react adversely more readily to atmospheric conditions than natural fibers. Synthetic fibers are sensitive to heat, sunlight and steam. Shrinking, hiking seams, puckering and flaring are common characteristics.

Velvet

Velvet nap will crush and may be directional. Surcharges will apply for hand stitching on some products.

Washed Goods

Washed fabrics are processed to achieve a casual and soft appearance. Characteristics such as wrinkling, fading, and puckering are normal. Widths may vary. Bow and bias may be in excess of industry standards and guidelines.

Wrinkling

Wrinkling is a characteristic of linen and cotton blend fabrics.

Terms & Conditions

Aftermarket Finishes

Merchandise cannot be returned once it has undergone a process such as flame-proofing, water repelling, stain resistance, piece-dying, washing or dry cleaning.

Back Orders

If you approve your order as a back order and are given an expected shipment or arrival date, please note that back orders may arrive earlier or later than anticipated. Cancellations may be granted (as described below) only prior to the vendor processing the order.

Cancellations

Orders using RM COCO fabric may not be canceled when an order has been confirmed. C.O.M. order may not be canceled after the order has been started.

No changes will be accepted once confirmation with ship date has been sent.

Collections

If your account is given to a collection agency you will be responsible for all collection & attorney fees.

Colors

Colors are not guaranteed. Due to color variability in computer and screen monitors, we have no liability if colors of the products do not match their display on the website.

Damaged Goods

If merchandise is lost or damaged in transit, please follow these four steps.

- Have the delivery person note and sign for any shortages or damages on both carrier's and your copy of the delivery receipt or freight bill. Do not refuse the merchandise unless you can see that the merchandise is clearly damaged and will not be usable.
- Open all containers immediately and inspect the merchandise's condition, even if your installation is not until a later date. Take photos of outside of packaging BEFORE opening box to document damage. Also take photos of product damage after opening. Damage or shortage MUST be reported to Customer Service immediately.
- 3. Contact Custom Creations staff immediately for carrier damage. Contact the freight carrier for inspection of truck shipments. Keep the merchandise in the original shipping container and packaging.
- 4. After contacting the delivery carrier, call Custom Creations staff to request a replacement order.

Deposits

Orders exceeding credit limit require a deposit. C.O.D. and prepay orders for custom, special order products and samples must be prepaid including freight.

RM COCO Account Guidelines:

To ensure a smooth order process, please follow these guidelines when placing your order with RM COCO:

- 1. **Order Placement:** Place your order with RM COCO before shipping the fabric to generate a confirmation order number. A quote prior to ordering is recommended.
- 2. **Fabric Shipment:** If you already have the fabric in your possession, please include the completed form with the fabric roll.
- Remnant Material: Please be aware that remnant material will be discarded after fabrication. Requests for the return of remnant material are subject to a \$15 net processing fee.
- 4. **Processing Fees:** A \$35 net processing fee will be applied for the following:
 - · Rolls arriving without proper identification.
 - · Sending less than the required yards of fabric.
 - · Non-sheer fabrics not rolled on a tube.

Attention RM COCO Dealer: Please ensure the completion of this form and send a copy to your fabric supplier. Failure to do so may result in delays and additional processing charges.

Procedure for Submitting C.O.M. Fabrics to RM COCO

- 1. Order Placement: Initiate the order with RM COCO before dispatching the fabric: Our Customer Service team will promptly respond with an order confirmation number.
- **2. C.O.M Identification Form:** COMPLETE A COPY OF THE C.O.M. IDENTIFICATION FORM and forward it to the fabric supplier. If you already have the fabric in your possession, kindly include the completed form with the fabric roll.
- **3. Fabric Shipment:** Ship the fabric rolled on a tube: avoid folding. Ensure that all fabrics are clearly marked with the face identified, and indicate the upward direction.

 - 3. Non-sheer fabrics not rolled on a tube.

C.O.M. Fabric Guidelines

RM COCO offers the customization of fabric soft shades, draperies, side panels, top treatments, cornices, headboards, pillows, and bedding products using your customer's own material (C.O.M.).

What materials are suitable?

RM COCO highly recommends to use drapery weight cotton and cotton blends for window treatments. While drapery weight polyesters can also be considered, it's important to be aware that these fabrics may exhibit varying degrees of billowing. Exercise caution when using specific drapery weight embroideries, and they have the potential to cause puckering effects on seams and the final product. Laces, open weaves, and casements may not maintain an exact shape, often resulting in uneven hems due to inherent variations. Linen, known for its tendency to wrinkle and crease, imparts a relaxed and casual aesthetic to draperies, though it may not be the best choice for those seeking a polished look. Shrinkage is a concern with linen fabrics when exposed to moisture.

In window treatment construction, it is advisable to steer clear of upholstery material, vinyl, and materials with backing whenever possible. However, these materials are deemed acceptable for use in cornices and headboards.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Draperies are meticulously tabled, and are sized as exact as possible. However, because of the "give" in some fabrics, there is a tolerance of up to ½" in length and width. Some knits and casements may vary as much as 1" or more. Please consider this when measuring for drapery finished length.
- Patterns are matched from the top down. Plaids, because of the wavy nature of the weave, we cannot guarantee the lines will be straight or match at the seams.
- Draperies are fan-folded, labeled with size, room tag, and sidemark, encased in plastic tubing and carefully packed in specially designed drapery boxes. Draperies may be flat folded when fabric or sizes do not allow to be fan folded.

FULLNESS RECOMMENDATIONS

- Fullness chosen depends on application.
- More fullness equals more fabric used.
- Fullness is indicated on price charts to help you determine the number of widths in your drapery.

- Standard linings for drapery:
 - RM Designer Everyday Lining
 - RM Designer Thermafoam
 - RM Designer Super Sateen
 - RM Designer Royal Sateen

These linings are available at the price stated in the charts. Should you want to substitute for a lining outside of the ones mentioned above, the pricing will be adjusted for the difference in lining cost with the exception of blackout linings.

- Blackout lining please be aware that the black pigment between the white/ivory coatings may show through when sewn causing the thread to look darker than normal. Also, pin holes of light may show where sewn. This is more noticeable on light colored fabrics as the stitched areas will appear as a gray thread even though white was used.
- Lining hems are 2½" doubled, set up 1½" from the bottom of face fabric hem so that the hem stitchings line up.

WIDE-WIDTH HELPFUL INFORMATION

- Most seamless fabrics are 118" wide. These fabrics are usually railroaded to avoid seams.
- The maximum finished length for seamless fabrics is the fabric width minus 18".
- Most seamless fabrics are shown railroaded in the samples. Please verify direction before order drapery so the pattern direction will be correct on your finished product.

<u>Shipping</u>

- Shipments are F.O.B. workroom in Cape Girardeau, Missouri and will be shipped complete via regular ground unless otherwise noted.
- You will be charged freight and handling on all shipments.

DELIVERY

 Production dates are set once all items needed to produce your order are received in the workroom. Every effort will be made to meet or beat that date, however these are estimated dates. Please add shipping time to this date.

- All cord shroud tape is hand tacked at appx. 6-8" apart vertically.
- Fabric patterns are matched from the top down.

LINING

- On linings, you may specify RM Designer Weather Guard, RM Designer Everyday Lining, RM Designer Thermafoam, RM Designer Super Sateen or RM Designer Royal Satin at the price stated in your chart at no additional cost.
- Should you need other linings, the cost will be adjusted for the difference in the lining cost.
- Regular blackout may be used, but may have light showing through where sewn. See page 32 or more information.

SHIPPING

- All shades are bagged and carefully boxed. Shipments are FOB workroom Cape Girardeau, Missouri and will be shipped regular ground unless otherwise specified. You will be charged for freight and handling.

SHADE OPERATING SYSTEMS

EASYLIFT

This is the standard shade system. Minimum board width is 18". A white or ivory beaded chain (to match your lining color) is used in a continuous loop. A cord tension device is attached to the bead chain and must be installed for the shade to function. With this added feature this shade will meet child safety standards.

CORDLESS (SPRING ROLLER)

This shade system is fabricated within an aluminum tube. The spring roller is inside the tube. The spring allows for lowering and raising the shade from the pull ring at the center bottom of the shade in the back. It is very easy to use with a smooth lifting and lowering action. Minimum board depth of $2\frac{1}{2}$ " and minimum shade width is 30".

MOTORIZED (SOMFY)

Shades are available to have a Somfy motorized lift system. See page 32 for more information on how to price this system. The motor is encased in a tube and controlled with a remote control, smart phone or tablet. Minimum board width is 30". The battery will hold a charge for appx. 1 year.

How to Price Somey Motorized Shades

BLACKOUT LININGS

Blackout linings are manufactured by coating a base fabric with layers of acrylic foam to increase it's light-blocking properties. A layer of white/ivory, then black, then white/ivory for a total of 3 layers. During the sewing process, as the needle goes through the blackout lining a little bit of the black foam attached to the thread and pulls through to the face of the fabric. This makes the thread appear 'black' in color. This will be very noticeable on light colored face fabrics (Image 1). Also, during sewing, as the needle goes through the fabric and lining it will create pin holes where light will come through (Image 2). These are both inherent properties of blackout linings.
