Let's look at the trends predicted for 2025 in several design areas to see if they seem on target or if consumer needs are also pushing additional trends to the forefront.

As each year begins, many wait with bated breath for Pantone® to announce its "Color of the Year" with the same anticipation given to the Oscar, Emmy, or Tony award ceremonies. This announcement from Pantone® is significant as its color formulations are the universally accepted standard for precise color matching worldwide. Pantone® is a force in the world of color, but as we will see with almost every other category that we will examine, the days of one source being the be-all-end-all authority on anything are over. Consumers are the final decision-makers of what trends are universally accepted.

Color predictions by Pantone® are met with applause, thought to be ahead of their time, or Pantone® is loathed for their selection! Several years ago, for example, they predicted an emerald green color that never really took off in home furnishing products. Today it is a much sought-after color for interiors.

For 2025, the Pantone Color Institute has selected PANTONE 17-1230 Mocha Mousse as its Color of the Year. Mocha Mousse is a warming, brown hue imbued with richness. It nurtures us with the suggestion of the delectable qualities of chocolate and coffee, answering our desire for comfort.

With its sophisticated, earthy elegance, Mocha Mousse can stand alone or serve as a versatile foundation, enhancing a wide range of palettes and applications, from minimalist to richly detailed designs, across all color-focused industries. Leatrice Eiseman, executive director of the Pantone Color Institute, said the color evokes "thoughtful indulgence" "Sophisticated and lush, yet at the same time an unpretentious classic, Mocha Mousse extends our perceptions of the browns from being humble and grounded to embrace the aspirational and luxe."

Many manufacturers are already gearing up to produce at least a portion of their new product offerings in this spotlighted color. Will Mocha Mousse-colored products be met with open arms by consumers? Is the color ahead of its time, or will it be cast off as an unlivable color? Only the next twelve months will tell for sure!

What other influences will there be in style, trends, and colors that will impact our lives in the coming year? Here are some of the predictions by product category.

INTERIOR FABRICS

Interior design is a dynamic world where trends ebb and flow. One constant is the importance of textiles in shaping a space's personality.

Velvet Still Reigns: This year, royal velvet fabric is taking center stage in fashion and home interiors. Its rich texture and regal look make it a favorite for creating statement pieces.

Take It To The Max: Maximalism continues to trend for 2025, with layered textures leading the charge. Upholstery fabrics like velvet, chenille, and bouclé bring depth and character to any room.

Chenille Returns: Chenille fabric, known for its soft, fuzzy surface will make a comeback in 2025. This fabric adds warmth and texture to window treatments, making it perfect for creating a cozy, inviting atmosphere in living rooms and bedrooms.

Bring Nature Home: Biophilic design remains a cornerstone of interior trends. Fabrics mimicking natural elements, earthy tones, organic patterns, and textures reminiscent of bark or moss will be all the rage in 2025. Botanical prints featuring leaves, flowers, and vines are increasingly

popular for window treatments. These patterns add a fresh, vibrant touch to any room and work well in traditional and modern interiors.

Earth Friendly: Eco-conscious living drives choices in 2025, and upholstery fabrics are no exception. Recycled or up-cycled materials, organic, and eco-friendly performance textiles are gaining traction. Choosing sustainable fabrics helps reduce environmental impact while ensuring long-lasting quality. Also look for organic cotton, linen, bamboo, and hemp fabrics to be popular as they are grown without pesticides and fertilizers making them healthier for the home.

Take To The Walls: Fabric on walls is a nostalgic trend that will be gaining favor once again in 2025. Fabric wall décor comes in all sorts of shapes, sizes, and styles. You can try more traditional options like wall tapestries or upholstered walls, or get a bit more creative by hanging embroidered art or fabric panels. The most common way would be to apply a fabric as you normally would a wallpaper.

Performance, Performance: As consumers increasingly seek out multi-functional and durable home products, high-performance fabrics are becoming a key trend in window treatments. These fabrics are designed to offer a range of benefits, from light control to energy efficiency, while maintaining a stylish appearance. Fabrics offering stain-resistant finishes, thermal or insulating properties, or light-filtering properties will all be on trend in the coming year.

PAINT

While timeless shades (think rich neutrals) will never go out of style, designers are seeing many adventurous paint hues for the coming year. Paint trends for 2025 do not all agree with the prediction from Pantone®. Large wall areas require a different approach than accent and trend colors in other product areas. Expect to hear the term "color drenching" used often in the coming year. Color drenching is where walls, woodwork, and ceilings are all painted the same color. Picasso originated this trend in 1901 with his Blue and Rose periods, which saw him celebrate the strength of one color. Here is a look at the colors our preeminent paint companies predict will be popular in 2025.

Benjamin Moore

Benjamin Moore has become a leader in predicting trending interior paint colors for some time now. For 2025, the company has selected Cinnamon Slate (2113-40) as their selection for Color of the Year, a delicate mix of heathered plum and velvety brown. This nuanced color brings a modern sensibility, smooth familiarity, and enduring style to any room setting.

Sherwin-Williams

Sherwin-Williams has abandoned selecting a single color as their Color of the Year for 2025 and opting for what they have named the 2025 Color Capsule. The company feels this grouping of nine colors is better-rounded than a single color selection. The nine colors are as follows;

- 1. Grounded (SW 6089): Made to envelop spaces in the comfort of its eternally calming nature, this versatile brown imparts richness and the stability of a refined earthen tone.
- 2. Sunbleached (SW 9585): This foundation color is poised between warm and cool, an adaptable and airy light neutral that is deeper than white, not quite gray, and ventures beyond beige or taupe.
- 3. Chartreuse (SW 0073): This historic color could not be more relevant than in 2025. This vibrant yellow-green brings a joyful, tropical brightness that is eclectic and versatile.
- 4. Rain Cloud (SW 9639): This stormy, deep gray-blue hue will bridge classic design and contemporary updates.
- 5. Clove (SW 9605): With a depth of tone that is nearly black, this entrancing brown is a cozy neutral that will soothe and bring comfort.
- 6. Malabar (SW 9110): This sandy-beige neutral can turn any environment into a soft, inviting haven. It will be ideal for layering with delicate, warm hues to create serenity in an abundance of design aesthetics.
- 7. Bosc Pear (SW 9390): A quintessential color with a golden hue that embodies the shift toward luxe organic tones and styles that hearken back to bygone eras.
- 8. White Snow (SW 9541): With a brilliantly bright light reflectance value of 90, this pure white will be a favorite among design professionals for a light and spacious result.
- Mauve Finery (SW 6282): This subdued, sophisticated mauve brings botanical beauty and a dreamy quality that adorns spaces with refreshing appeal as a wall color or an accent.

Glidden

Glidden's motto for 2025 is "Purple is not just encouraged, it is permitted!" Not surprisingly they have selected Purple Basil as their Color

of the Year for 2025. This color represents the appreciation for self-discovery and self-expression that has led to the rise of maximalism across industries, including design, fashion, and consumer goods.

BEHR

For 2025 BEHR encourages us to add warmth and rich allure to our home. Their selection for Color of the Year is called Rumors (MQ1-15). This is a deep ruby red that will add a dramatic flair to any room setting.

Dutch Boy

Dutch Boy Paints has selected Mapper Blue (Blue 429-5DB) as their 2025 Color of the Year. Mapped Blue helps set a timeless foundation for a home, staying on-trend as personal style evolves. This beautiful, mediumtone blue with slight yellow undertones adds a modern charm to any space.

Valspar

Valspar's Color of the Year is a shade of blue named Encore (8002-45G). An atmospheric blue that is at home anywhere, it is set to be a favorite in 2025.

Here are some additional paint color palettes that we should see trend in the coming year.

Quietly Colorful Hues: According to paint manufacturers, the color story of 2025 is an expected consumer shift from popular neutrals to hues that are "quietly colorful." These diffused, mellow shades are a fantastic way to introduce and layer color into any space. Not only can they bring harmony to a room, but they also complement any design style. From light blues and greens that have been dubbed the "new neutrals" to soft pinks and peaches that add a soothing touch and even grounding shades like earthy browns, a hint of color can be found for any room setting.

Earthy Neutrals: Earth tones will play an important role in color selection in 2025. Rather than the cooler undertones of the past five years, look for warmer neutrals with stronger earth-toned hues. The same mellow undertones that make softly colorful shades popular are expected to resonate with consumers in the year ahead.

Deep Blues: In 2020, global color forecasters predicted that blue would be the color of the decade, and blue will continue to be popular in 2025. This year, paint manufacturers anticipate consumers will be attracted to deeper, more complex blues, such as cerulean and Prussian blue. No matter what end of the spectrum, some form of blue will always be popular. While softer shades of blue will always be popular, it is time to embrace the color's bolder energy in the coming year.

Soft Pinks: Not the bubble gum pinks of children's bedrooms or the soft baby hues of nurseries, but more mature and muted shades. When used as a neutral shade or paired with brown tones, subtle pinks can read like a warm cream or color-infused version of tan.

Dramatic Reds: Red is in! Not just the softer reds that skew pink (which are also cropping up more), but true, eye-catching ruby reds. Whether used for full-room applications or smaller accents, a pop of red inspires confidence. Red also infuses glamour, mystery, and an energetic quality into the room.

Glowing Yellows: Golden accents have graced interiors for as long as anyone can remember, primarily in textile and tile form. For 2025, the color family is becoming a more prominent paint choice. In 2025, expect to see this cheerful hue in paint form that brings light and warmth to homes. These softer tones serve as a backdrop for accent colors and furnishing styles. In the coming year, look for more saturated yellows being played up to make more of a statement.

WALLPAPER

The popularity of wallpaper has been on the rise for several years now. It may not be to the extreme we saw in the 1980s and 1990s, but it is popular

nonetheless. Wallpaper will only become more popular in the coming year. Here are the trends expected to be in the wallpaper limelight in 2025.

Total Immersion: Total immersion wallpaper started to gain traction last year and is predicted to be even stronger in 2025. Gone are the days of the accent wall. Those are being seen as passé and only for the timid. Look for wallpapers and murals that wrap around all four walls to be a design trend in the coming year. Last year we heard about the "fifth wall" for wallpaper applications. This trend will only grow in 2025. The 'fifth wall' refers to the ceiling. The revival of ceiling papers has been slowly gaining popularity. Originating in European interiors, look for American homes to embrace the decoration of the ceiling in room settings for 2025.

Mural Fascination: Murals have gained popularity in the past few years and are predicted to skyrocket in 2025. Once, they could only be done by hand or printed using silk screens or gravure rollers, which meant the repeat was limited. With the advent of digital printing, large-scale patterns or scenic murals can now span the entire wall or room with no repeat. These statement-making wallpapers create artistic showcases by completely wrapping the room and transforming flat surfaces into interesting focal points.

Flora And Fauna: Botanical and tropical wallpaper prints will never go out of style as they create serene and peaceful feelings in every space. In the coming year, we will see botanical and tropical wallpapers mixed with traditional designs for residential or commercial use.

If classic florals are not your style, then the 2025 trend for wallpaper depicting botanicals and exotic animals may be just right for your home. It is predicted that 2025 will be filled with insects, oversized botanicals, birds, and exotic animals. Animal-inspired patterns have been loved for some time. Look for 2025 to showcase bold and unique horticultural prints mixed with lively depictions of wildlife. Texture adds depth and dimension to any room, and textured wallpapers such as Grasscloth, linen, paper weaves, and raffias add a sense of warmth and create inviting spaces while elevating the overall design.

Let It Shine: Metallics have long been incorporated in wallpaper patterns as they add an uplifting feature that provides variety to a one-dimensional design. Metallic accents will continue to trend in 2025.

Show Your Stripes and Plaids: Decorating with stripes will always establish a timeless look. In the coming year, there will be a resurgence in preppy, traditional patterns in wallpaper trends. Rather than busy abstract designs, opt for a design that feels elegant yet impactful. Plaid wallpaper is the most effective step to nail the classic Americana aesthetic. These patterns are reminiscent of Ralph Lauren's early designs. They can add chicness and tradition in one bold yet cozy print.

FLOORING

With global attention on major holidays like Diwali and Día de los Muertos, marigolds specifically will be in the zeitgeist for their vibrant orange and yellow colors and peppery taste. Baldor, the specialty foods wholesaler in New York City, reports that they have had a 164% increase in marigold sales in recent months.

Mushroom Madness: Functional mushrooms have been on the scene for a while but in the nebulous "wellness" way. In the past couple of years, psilocybin mushrooms have crossed the threshold from fringe to mainstream as they help with clarity and calm. We will see more and more of this manifesting at the dinner table in the coming year.

All Things French: The solid comfort of French cooking is increasingly back in vogue in America for 2025. Look for new takes on classic dishes such as steak frites and short rib Bourguignon but at a more affordable price than in years past.

Plant-Based Perfection: There was a time when dining out meant eating meat, with few options for vegan diets. As more diners shift towards plant-based eating for both health and environmental reasons, and in 2025, restaurants will be increasingly adapting to this trend.

Asian Influences: It seems silly to say Asian cuisine is on the rise as it has been around for millennia. This trend is aided by the growing number of Asian (Southeast Asian in particular) markets, restaurants, ingredients, and prepared foods is dramatic and is influencing all kinds of cooking for 2025.

Gochujang, sambal, yuzu, calamansi, matcha, and kimchi (to name but a few) appear more and more on packaging and menus. Sushi, barbecue, ramen, bulgogi, and Asian dumplings will be available in restaurants and local grocery stores in abundance in the coming year.

Look for chili crunches and crisps to continue gaining popularity in 2025. Expect these to appear

in chili oils infused with crunchy bits (usually fried garlic or shallots). Salsa Macha is the Mexican version of chili crunch, with nuts, seeds, and spices added to the hot chili oil.

Sweet Tooth: Everyone loves a good dessert, but in the days of weight-conscious Americans, what can satisfy our sweet tooth without too much guilt? For 2025, it is predicted to be the classic Pavlova! This meringue dessert is expected to have a big year with professional and home bakers alike. This airy concoction is just whipped egg white meringue with added sugar and baked until it reaches a solid consistency. Top with fresh fruit, chocolate, or fruit sauce for the perfect ending to the perfect meal. It is so hip that it is even featured in the popular cartoon Bluey!

Spread The Word: Everything old is new again in 2025. The condiment predicted to be the "it" spread in the coming year is classic mayonnaise. Not only the classic flavor but a whole new cast of supporting flavors. Expect to see dill pickle, hot Giardiniera, Dijon, cilantro lime, and hickory bacon flavors coming to a sandwich bar or grocery aisle in the coming year.

Grab A Salty Snack: The snack aisle is a perfect place to set a food trend for 2025. Our love for salty snacks will mix with our desire to experience global flavors in the coming year. Snacks, like chips and popcorn, will take on new and unique flavors to create fusion foods that will have mass appeal and entice consumers to try something new. Think mango sticky rice chips, chili crunch oil edamame with mixed nuts, or lemon tahini snack mix.

Beverage Trends

Elevated Water: The bottled water craze is nothing new, but we will hear more and more about "elevated water" in 2025. With the beverage space booming from people looking to level up hydration habits with trendy reusable bottles to innovative sips, consumers are thirsty for beverages with health benefits, like added electrolytes, vitamins, and antioxidants.

Drinkable Flowers: Marigolds will be popular in both the food and drink categories in 2025. Look for other floral notes to gain popularity in beverages as well. The Gen-Z population favors the hibiscus, lavender, and cherry blossoms already popping up on beverage menus in hot and cold coffee, steeped into lemonade and tea, and adding a happy hue to cocktails. Expect the flavors of elderflower and rose to appeal to those looking for sensory and calming experiences.

Move Over Negroni: The cocktail expected to emerge as the cocktail darling for 2025 is the classic Manhattan. Deemed the "perfect" drink a traditional Manhattan is made with whiskey, sweet vermouth, a dash of bitters, and served in a coupe or champagne glass.

Sparkling Tea: It has been predicted that in 2025, tea will turn heads in the dessert aisle, in canned drinks, as the focus of adult tea parties, and in wine-sized bottles of sparkling tea. Tea has the complex aromatics and bitter tannins of wine without the alcohol. Tea is a fantastic option for those wanting a refreshing celebratory sipper that is non-alcoholic. There will be tea talk everywhere you turn in the coming year. There will be new steeping formats (tea strips, cold-brew bags for water bottles and powders) and a wave of new hot products like plant-based milk teas.

Low And No Proof: For the last few years, we have seen a sharp rise in the prevalence of mocktails, low-proof or non-alcoholic spirits, beer, and wine. As more people look to refreshing drink options without alcohol, restaurant menus. In the coming year, look for small-batch producers to offer many tasty options.
